Please answer the following questions to help us ensure we are providing safe environments for all our patients.

1. Within the last 14 days, have you had contact with someone with or under investigation for COVID-19, or are ill with respiratory illness? **YES** **NO**
2. Within the last 24 hours, have you had a fever? Do you recent lost of taste or smell? **YES** **NO**
3. Do you have a cold, cough, runny nose, sore throat or flu-like symptoms? **YES** **NO**
